TITLE: No Smoking Policy

Introduction

As per Victorian Law, Smoking is banned at all of Victoria's patrolled beaches, in the areas between the red-and-yellow lifesaving flags and within a 50-metre radius of a red-and-yellow flag. This ban applies during patrolled times, when one or more red-and-yellow flags installed by a Life Saving Victoria club are in place.

Smoking is also banned within 10 metres (about two car lengths) of any public outdoor sporting venue during an organised under-18s event. The ban also applies to outdoor drinking areas located within 10 metres of an outdoor sporting venue during an organised under-age sporting event or training session.

The Anglesea Surf Life Saving Club (ASLSC) is committed to achieving and maintaining a productive environment that meets the highest standards of health and safety. To this extent the ASLSC intends to not only adhere to Victorian Law but also extend these requirements to provide a safer environment for our members and guests.

Policy

Smoking is banned within 10-metres of the Club house and in all interior spaces. In addition, smoking is banned on the upper and lower grassed areas and both upper and lower club house balconies.

Signage is to be placed around the exterior of the club house and at each entrance. Members will be reminded of the policy in addition to the Victorian Law's relating to smoking via club members communication channels.

Responsibility

All members are required to adhere to this policy. Should a member fail to adhere to this policy they may be referred to the Judiciary Committee.

All groups hiring the club rooms and Captain Moonlite visitors are required to adhere to this policy.
