Memberships Renewals:

Your current membership (including insurance) has expired. To ensure you are adequately insured – particularly if you have started training – renew your membership and pay your membership fee as soon as possible using your Members Portal account. Memberships are now overdue as they were due by the 31st October.

Please visit the Membership Information page on our website for prices, information, guidelines and links to the online membership request and payment process.

Member Requirements:

- Renew your membership details for season 2016/17. This includes making any changes to your contact details;
- Pay your 2016/17 membership fee;
- Proof of your Working With Children Check assessment status. If over 18 and involved in any
 junior programs (including ALL Nipper parents) or patrols, ensure your Working With
 Children Check is up to date. If you hold a WWCC for another organisation you will need to
 change your details to add Life Saving Victoria and Anglesea SLSC to your list of registered
 organisations.

Please note that a Family Subscription is not a membership category, but a payment type. Every member must have an individual membership (e.g. Associate, Active Senior, Active Junior, Junior Activities Member, etc.). If you are renewing your family, you must make sure you renew each member individually. You can do this easily if you create a Family Group in your Members Portal. If you wish to add a new child to your Family Group, you must complete a membership application and notify the Club Office first.

All memberships will remain pending until ALL membership requirements have been met.

Nipper Program – Please note that simply renewing and paying your membership fee does not automatically enrol you into the 2016/17 Nipper Program. You will need to complete the Online Nipper Program Registration Form. ALL membership requirements MUST be met BEFORE you can register. A confirmation email will be sent out each Monday.

Notes from the October Directors Meeting:

The following are the key highlights from the meeting held on 19th October 2016:

GENERAL:

- The Club has been successful in receiving a grant for Bollard lighting for the upper car park.
- A report was provided about the recent Governance Advisory sub-committee which met on the 13th October. A set of Governance Principles for the club were developed and agreed to by the Board.

STRATEGIC ITEMS:

- A proposal on future Development Week Candidate Selection Criteria was presented, discussed and agreed to. This will be communicated to members in the coming month.
- The club received a letter of support from the Great Ocean Road Coastal Committee for the Building Redevelopment.
- A draft policy to improve the standard of IRB Driver training in the club was discussed. The focus is on increased in-water training and with the final assessment not to occur until minimum inwater training hours are completed. The Policy was accepted and will be implemented.
- A report was provided about the Risk Workshop on the 9th October that the Directors participated in. The format of the key items and action integration with other Board and Club action lists is being finalised for further consideration.

A second member has just had a successful sale through Great Ocean Properties which with cheques for both sales in the process of being processed...More to come in the next edition of the G&W Rag.


